The content in this book supports and is divided by the NCTM content standards: number and operations, algebra, geometry, measurement, and data analysis and probability. Timesaving teaching aids such as skill checks and cumulative tests are included along with an NCTM correlation chart, pretests, answer key, and vocabulary cards.

The contents of this Math workbook include multiple chapters and units covering all the required Common Core Standards for this grade level. Similar to a standardized exam, you can find questions of all types, including multiple choice, fill-in-the-blank, true or false, match the correct answer and free response questions. These carefully written questions aim to help students reason abstractly and quantitatively using various models, strategies, and problem-solving techniques. The detailed answer explanations in the back of the book help the students understand the topics and gain confidence in solving similar problems.

Each page in the Common Core Math Workouts for grade 6 contains two “workouts”—one for skills practice and one for applying those skills to solve a problem. Content is aligned with the Common Core State Standards for Mathematics and includes Geometry, Ratio and Proportional Relationships, The Number System, Expressions and Equations, and Statistics and Probability. They are filled with skills practice and problem-solving practice exercises that correspond to each standard.
