Partnerships are required to file annual information returns with the Internal Revenue Service to report the income, deductions, losses, gains, etc. from its business operations. This tax obligation, however, does not include income taxes—a partnership does not have to pay federal income tax. Instead, the formation passes its income through; all profits or losses—and their attached tax obligation—are transferred to the individual partners of the formation.

A limited partnership may be formed by the general partner by executing a partnership agreement (See Section 121-110 of the Revised Limited Partnership Act) and filing a Certificate of Limited Partnership pursuant to Section 121-201 of the Revised Limited Partnership Act.

The Uniform Partnership Act of 1997 is a modern form and was later adopted by all states except Louisiana. Moreover, it creates a partnership as a distinct legal entity, and not simply as a collection of partners. The most recent amendments were introduced in 2011 and 2013 via the Harmonization of Business Entity Acts.
