The number of rows that the Windows 8 start screen displays on the screen is determined by the screen resolution of the operating system. Windows 8 displays four rows on systems with a resolution of 1024x768, five on a system with a resolution of 1900x1080 and six on a 1920x1200 screen resolution. The standard values can be modified in the Windows Registry so that more or less rows are displayed on the start screen of the operating system.

The best way to fight a crowded screen when working in Windows 8 is to experiment with your screen resolution — the amount of information your screen can display. Windows 8 requires a resolution of 1366 x 768 to snap an app to your desktop's side. Adjust the resolution for smaller screens

Whenever I do a remote desktop connection or change the resolution on my Windows 8 machine, the start screen will not scale back to 1920x1080. For example, if I remote desktop in and change the resolution to match the remote display, when I log out and go back to the Windows 8 box, the desktop resolution has been automatically reset to 1920x1080.
